

Check for Court Notifications

Notifications are available for 90 days in E-Filing, but are also are saved to the case record and can be seen under the NEF action.



Start at the Home page and click Notifications.



- 2. Use the **Search By** field to filter notifications by: All, Notification ID, Filing Description, Case Caption, or Case Number.
- 3. Enter the **Value** for the search criteria. Note that you can only enter one word as a value for your search. For example, only enter one name (Ex: Smith) if searching by Case Caption.
- 4. Click **Go**, and the filings that match the Search By criteria display in the grid.
- 5. Click to open and review the Notice of Electronic Filing (NEF) associated with the E-Filing. This opens a new tab. Click the tab to close the screen.
- 6. Click to open and review an E-Filed document. This opens a new tab. Click the tab to close the screen.



7. Click to enter a checkmark in a checkbox for the associated filing to either **Delete**, **Mark as Read** (□), or **Mark as Unread** (□).

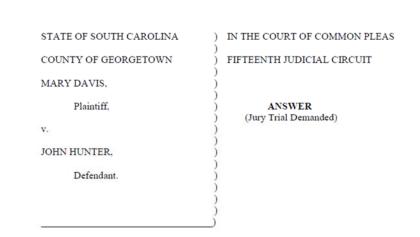
Example of Notice of Electronic Filing
