**PER CURIAM:** Frank Russick appeals the family court's final order removing his minor child from his care, granting permanent custody of the child to a relative, authorizing the Department of Social Services to forego reasonable efforts at reunification, and closing the case. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 63-7-1640 (Supp. 2022); § 63-7-1660 (2010 & Supp. 2022). Upon a thorough review of the record and the family court's findings of fact and conclusions of law pursuant to *Ex parte Cauthen*, 291 S.C. 465, 354 S.E.2d 381 (1987), we find no meritorious issues warrant briefing. Accordingly, we affirm the family court's ruling and relieve
