November 13, 2012 Columbia, South Carolina On November 8, 2012, the Richland County Circuit Court, the Honorable L. Casey Manning, ordered the State Law Enforcement Division (SLED) to seize all ballots in Richland County and supervise a count of those ballots by working with the South Carolina State Election Commission.

On November 9, 2012, Petitioner petitioned this Court for a writs of prohibition and injunction preventing the enforcement of the Circuit Court's order. The same day, this Court issued a stay and ordered Respondents to file a response.

Respondents South Carolina Democratic Party (SCDP) and Richland County Election Commission (RCEC), respectively the Plaintiff and Defendant in the Circuit Court action, have consulted through their respective counsel and after receiving adequate assurances from the RCEC that dismissal of the Circuit Court action and return of the seized ballots will result in an orderly, lawful count of votes cast in Richland County using the procedures proscribed by law, the SCDP has dismissed its case pursuant to Rule 41(a), SCRCP (attached as Exhibit A).

Respondent SCDP respectfully submits that this case is moot and should be dismissed. Respondent SCDP consents to the motion to dismiss filed by the RCEC and respectfully joins its request for an order (i) dismissing the Emergency Petition for Writs of Prohibition and Injunction; (ii) vacating all underlying Orders for a Temporary Restraining Order (including the Amended Order) issued by the Circuit Court; (iii) ordering the return of all ballots and materials seized by SLED to the County Commission; and (iv) providing for the RCEC to have until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, November 16, 2012, to complete its statutory obligations regarding the ballots cast in the 2012 General Election conducted on November 6, 2012.

AND WHEREFORE, the partial execution of that Order maintained the status quo in this dispute through the seizure and safekeeping of ballots in Richland County by the State Law Enforcement Division;

AND WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs have had time to consult with Defendants Richland County Election Commission (RCEC), Lillian McBride as Executive Director of the RCEC, and M. Elizabeth Crum as Chair of the RCEC through their respective counsel;

AND WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs have received adequate assurances that dismissal of this case and return of the seized ballots will result in an orderly, lawful count of votes cast in Richland County using the procedures proscribed by law;

Plaintiffs by and through their undersigned counsel hereby stipulate to the dismissal of this case—without prejudice—pursuant to Rule 41(a), SCRCP.

While not required by Rule 41(a), SCRCP, the undersigned have consulted with opposing counsel who has represented that the Defendants consent to this dismissal.
